- Ensuring the lounges are kept clean and tidy
- Ensure good health and safety regulations are adhered to at all times, for example, cleaning up spillage and reporting any issues
- Being aware of responsibilities under child protection legislation, and reporting concerns to DSL
- To record and report all accidents by following company procedures
- To carry out all reasonable duties as requested by any member of SLT
